I. CRITERIA FOR GRADUATION WITH HONORS

In order to be considered for graduation with honors, a candidate must have earned (1) a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.4 (2) a minimum of sixty (60) semester credits at Morgan, and (3) no grades below "C."

Summa Cum Laude (With highest honor)	3.80 - 4.00
Magna Cum Laude (With high honor).....	3.60 - 3.79
Cum Laude (With honor)	3.40 - 3.59

Candidates for graduation who have successfully pursued the University Honors Program will have the designation "Honors Work" beside their names on the commencement program.

II. CRITERIA FOR THE DEAN'S LIST

At the end of each semester, students who meet the criteria listed below shall be placed on the Dean's List. The student who has a semester grade-point average of 3.4 or higher (in 15 computable credits) with no corrective courses (i.e. Reading 101, Science 105, English 100, and Speech 100) qualifies for the Dean's List for that semester.

Full-time Students (12 semester hours or more)

15 or more computable semester hours
Semester GPA of 3.40 and above
No grade less than "C"
Cannot be enrolled in corrective courses
(i.e., Reading 101, Science 105, English 100, and/or Speech 100)

12 to 14 computable semester hours
Semester GPA of 3.60 and above
No grade less than "C"
Cannot be enrolled in corrective courses
(i.e., Reading 101, Science 105, English 100, and/or Speech 100)

III. HONORABLE MENTION

12 to 14 computable semester hours
Semester GPA of 3.40 to 3.59
No grade less than "C"
Cannot be enrolled in corrective courses
(i.e., Reading 101, Science 105, English 100, and/or Speech 100)

Part-time Students (6 to 11 semester hours)

6 to 11 computable semester hours
Semester GPA of 3.60 and above
No grade less than "C"
Cannot be enrolled in corrective courses
(i.e., Reading 101, Science 105, English 100, and/or Speech 100)
