

POLICY PROHIBITING EMPLOYMENT

Full-time graduate students who receive Teaching Assistantships or Research Assistantships regardless of the source of funding are prohibited from additional employment. Similarly, full-time graduate students who receive tuition awards and a fellowship are also prohibited from employment. Graduate students found in violation of the policy are subject to sanctions including, but not necessarily limited to: revocation of financial assistantships and/or fellowships; reduction in the amount of available financial assistance; repayment of stipend and/or dismissal from the School of Graduate Studies.
